

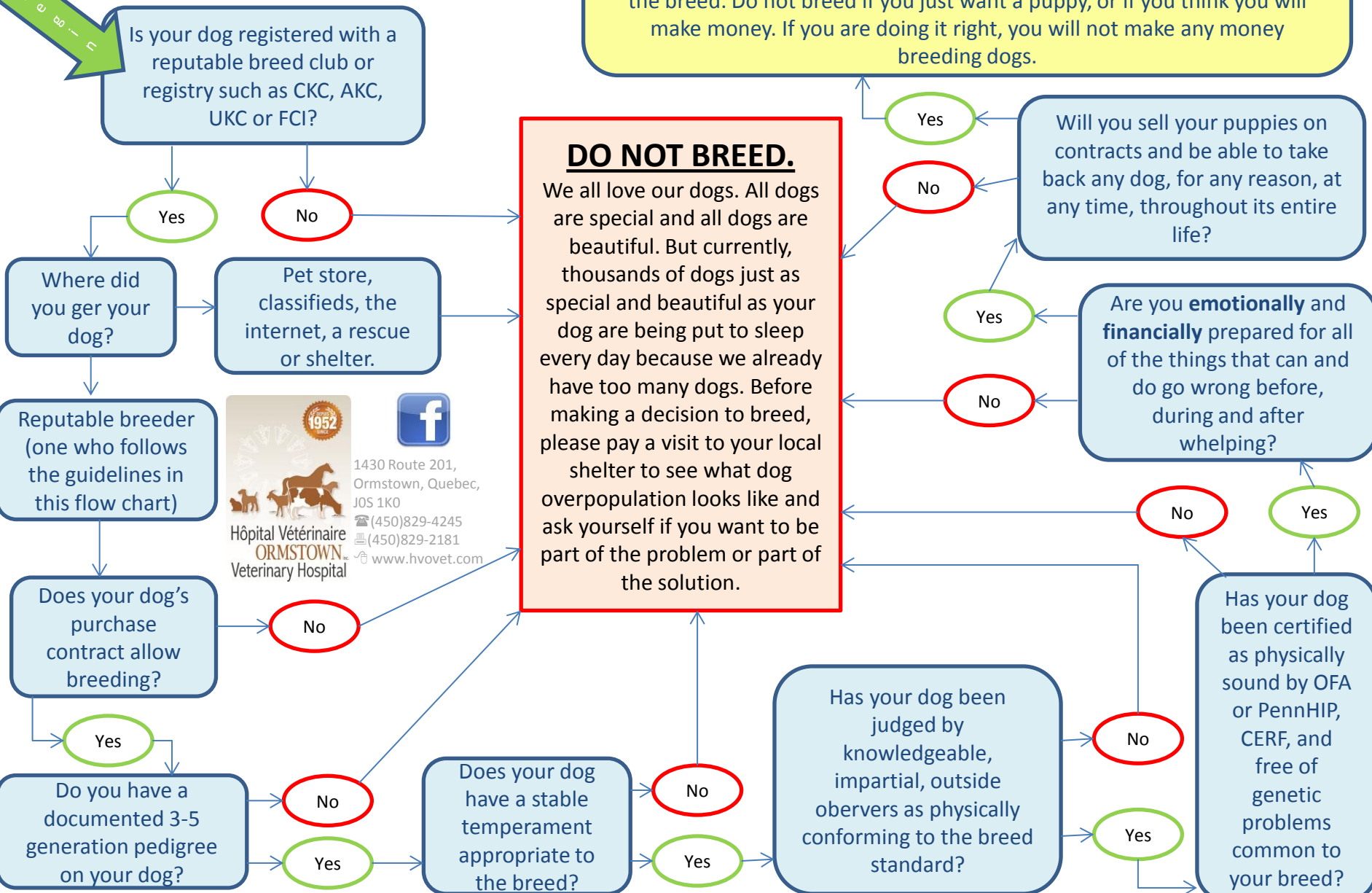
SHOULD YOU BREED YOUR DOG?
